Workbooks: If the book has spaces for students to write answers the KHS 2nd Hand Shop will **not accept a copy for sale if it has been used at all.** Rubbing out or using correction fluid will not make the book acceptable.

Unsellable books left for processing (*unlisted ePack components, wrong editions, unlisted books, workbooks with writing in them or books in very poor condition or with offensive drawings*) **will not be returned to you.** No receipts are issued, but this form can be consulted at the shop. Take a photo / copy of this form for your records.

Donations of books or uniforms can be deposited in the marked collection bin at the school office.

Books submitted after the deadline will still be accepted but may take longer to sell.

Personal information included on this form is securely stored and will only be used for correspondence regarding sale or collection of second hand goods. Personal information for seller cheques may be verified with Kew High School.

Books are graded as follows:

- Excellent:** As good as new, sell for approx. 75% of new price.
- Good:** The broadest category, sell for approx. 50% of new price.
- Poor:** Torn or missing cover or pages, stains, drawings, 5 or more pages with permanent marks (ink or highlighter, etc.), sell for approx. 25% of new price.

Poor quality books are regarded as donations - you will not be paid for them.

Unsold books may be discounted during the year, this will reduce your payment.

You will receive a cheque for 70% of the selling price of good and excellent quality books **after they sell.** Cheques are issued in March and September. The remaining 30% commission, plus profits from selling donated or poor quality goods, goes towards funding Chaplaincy program.

This year, Campion has provided the option to purchase reactivation codes for more textbooks, as such, these books are not included in our eBook listing and are found in the above table. Below are the books for 2020 with eBooks, electronic access codes components (eBook, interactive text, digital).

PLEASE READ THE INSTRUCTION CAREFULLY AND FULLY before proceeding with selling a book. If you have any queries please contact Tracie Christopoulos (second hand book sales – shop volunteer 2shopkhs@gmail.com) before proceeding.

NB: IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE SELLER, not the Kew High School 2nd Hand Book Shop, to make sure the book code is active and indicate how many activations remain. The 2nd Hand Shop is not able to tell if a book has an active code or not or how many times it has been activated. Please contact the publishers to confirm activations – details supplied. Books that do not have an activation specified will be deemed to have NO active code and therefore sold at the cheapest price.

Pricing of eBooks will be on sliding scale depending on how many activations remain, the licensing restrictions and the quality of the book for sale.

Generally, if an access code has **never** been activated it will sell for 75% of new price, 50% for 2 and 25% for 1 remaining and for 0 remaining activations 25% of component book price (i.e. combo price minus access code price – not book price if sold independently).

Each book comes with a Student Access Card in the back of the book. This Student Access Card contains **FOUR codes** – scratch a strip to reveal the code. **You can activate one code and leave the card in the back of the book to allow access for three others.** In this way the printed book can be used across four years by four consecutive students.
