- Excellent: As good as new, sell for approx. 75% of new
price
Good: The broadest category, sell for approx. 50% of
new price
Poor: Torn or missing cover or pages, stains,
drawings, 5 or more pages with permanent
marks (ink or highlighter, etc.) sell for approx.
25% of new price.

**Poor quality books are regarded as donations - you will
not be paid for them.**

Unsold or overstocked books may be discounted during the
year, this will reduce your payment.

You will receive 70% of the selling price of good and
excellent quality books **after they sell.** Payments are
processed in February and September. The remaining 30%,
plus profits from selling donated or poor-quality goods, goes
to the work of the School Chaplain.
